History of St. Joseph Cemetery

St. Joseph Cemetery is affiliated with Corpus Christi Parish in Conneaut, Ohio. In 1901, St. Mary of the Immaculate Conception Church purchased five acres of land for a cemetery on the west side of Conneaut. The cemetery was dedicated to the patronage of St. Joseph. In 1981, the St. Joseph Shrine was added. Funds for the shrine were given in memory of loved ones. Names are engraved on the south side of the statue. Recently, statues of the Blessed Mother and the Infant of Prague were donated to the cemetery. St. Joseph Cemetery is for use by the Catholic Community.
