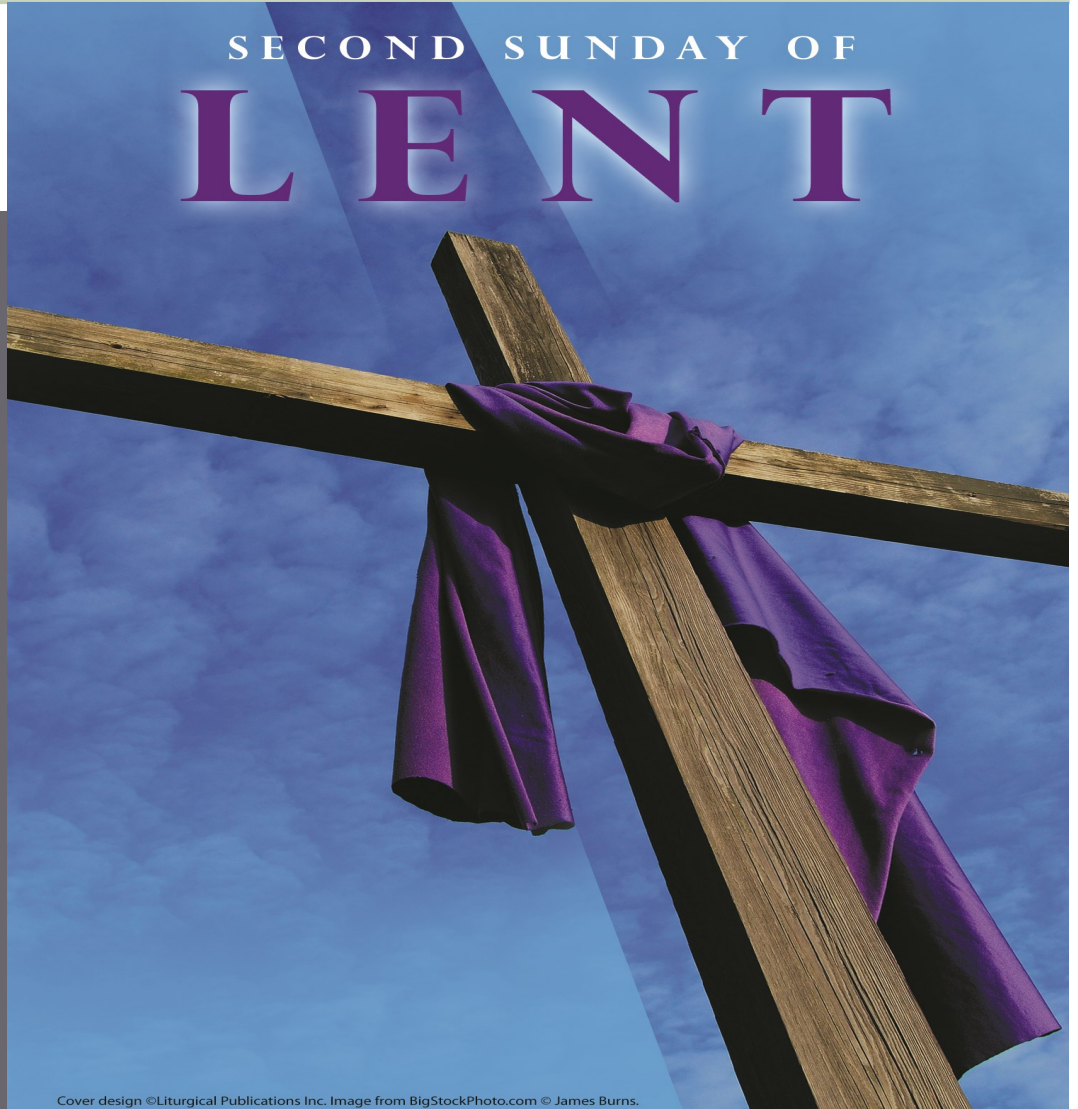

A Note from Father Keehner:

Some who heard my homily this past Sunday, the first Sunday of Lent, asked that the reflection on fasting and feasting be made available to them for further reflection. Since delivering my homily, I have found via the internet that this reflection is attributed to William Arthur Ward, an American teacher and pastor. It reads:

- Fast from judging others; feast on Christ dwelling in them.
- Fast from emphasis on differences; feast on the unity of life.
- Fast from apparent darkness; feast on the reality of light.
- Fast from thoughts of illness; feast on the healing power of God.
- Fast from words that pollute; feast on phrases that purify.
- Fast from discontent; feast on gratitude.
- Fast from anger; feast on patience.
- Fast from pessimism; feast on optimism.
- Fast from worry; feast on divine order.
- Fast from complaining; feast on affirmatives.
- Fast from unrelenting pressures; feast on unceasing prayer.
- Fast from hostility; feast on non-resistance.
- Fast from bitterness; feast on forgiveness.
- Fast from self-concern; feast on compassion for others.
- Fast from personal anxiety; feast on eternal truth.
- Fast from discouragements; feast on hope.
- Fast from facts that depress; feast on truths that uplift.
- Fast from listlessness; feast on enthusiasm.
- Fast from thoughts that weaken; feast on promises that inspire.
- Fast from shadows of sorrow; feast on the sunlight of serenity.
- Fast from idle gossip; feast on purposeful silence.
- Fast from problems that overwhelm; feast on prayer that is secure.

To this, given the great chasm dividing our nation and our culture, I have added:

Fast from outrage; feast on God's mercy.

It is my hope that in the midst of our Lenten devotions, in the midst of the physical fasting to which we are called, we will also take to heart the spiritual fasting encouraged by this reflection.

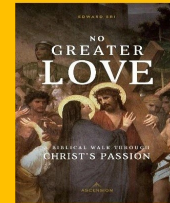

Lenten Regulations

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday are days of Fast & Abstinence from meat.

There is a limit of one full meal on these days for all between the ages of 18 and 59 inclusive.

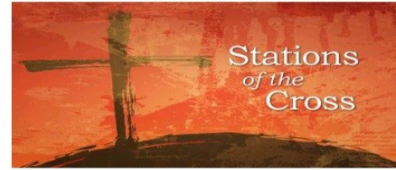
All Fridays in Lent are days of Abstinence. All who have reached their 14th year are bound to abstain totally from meat.

Easter Duty Obligation

After they have received their First Communion, Catholics are bound by the obligation of receiving Holy Communion at least once a year. This precept should be fulfilled during the Easter Season. Catholics are also bound to confess serious (mortal) sins at least once a year, but this is not limited to the Lenten/Easter Season.
