If you are from another parish and visiting, you can use your home parish envelope and it will be sent there.

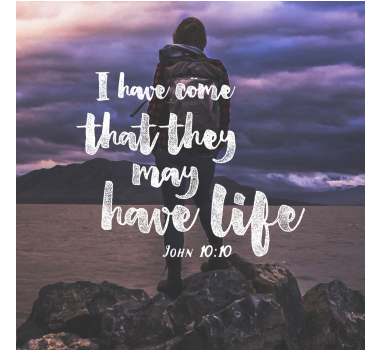
The Catholic Echo is replacing the Catholic Exponent
