NOTE: Mass that is broadcast through various media, including live-stream, **is not** intended as an alternative, nor does it fulfill the obligation for persons who are able to gather for a Sunday celebration and other Holy Days. **It is intended for the sick, homebound, imprisoned, etc. who are unable to attend Mass in person.**
