St. John SGO ~ If you pay Ohio income tax, you can receive a TAX CREDIT by making a contribution to the St. John Scholarship Granting Organization (SGO) before you file your 2025 taxes. It's like a boomerang –what you give to the St. John SGO comes back to you! If you are receiving a refund, your existing refund will increase by the amount you contribute (max \$750) to the Saint John SGO, so you "get your money back!" If you owe income tax, make a contribution (max \$750) to the St. John SGO to satisfy your payment to the state and keep your tax dollars local.
