

2020 Annual Bishop's Appeal Update:

Corpus Christi Parish: 25% (158 of 638 Households) responded. In addition to prayers and volunteering, \$20,704 was pledged.

<u>**Diocese of Youngstown**</u>: 26% of the 60,569 registered households responded with prayers and volunteering and pledges totaling \$3,229,228 toward the need of \$4 million.
