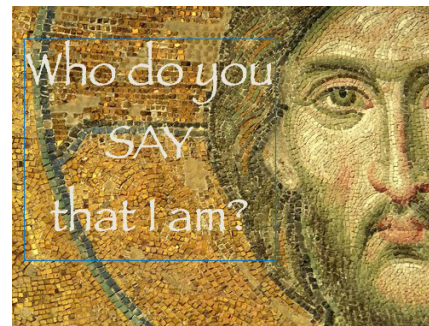

Faith Formation News...

The Church refers to parents as the "primary educators" of their children. The Code of Canon Law states, "parents are under a grave obligation to see to the religious and moral education of their children, as well as to their physical and civic training, as far as they can" (Code of Canon Law, c.1113).

The Faith Formation year begins **this weekend on Sunday, September 12** at 9am with a Family Day before the 11am Mass. All families are welcome. This is also Grandparents Day. We invite all grandparents to join us for this day.

Registration for children in grades 1-8 will take place **September 12 at Family Day**. Classes begin next **Sunday, September 19 at the Parish Center from 9:15am - 10:45am** The theme for the year is "**We are the Body of Christ**". Families who did not register their child/children on Family Day will have a chance register the morning of September 19 before class. Registration fee is \$35 per child or \$50 for a family of 2 or more children.
