Mr. Benjamin Garriga has recently completed formation to become a Leader of Prayer for Corpus Christi Parish.

A Leader of Prayer is a lay person commissioned to lead the faithful in acts of worship which in the past were often led by ordained clergy but which are not reserved exclusively to them.

According to diocesan directives, Leaders of Prayer are to be vested in an alb for all services conducted within the church building. The alb is a white garment, a baptismal garment. It is traditionally the garb of the people and not specifically clerical vesture. When the baptized put on the alb to minister in the liturgy, it becomes clear that they are doing so in virtue of their baptism and their share in the priesthood of Christ.

Benjamin is to be commended for the dedication and enthusiasm with which he has responded to the call by the parish to take part in this ministry. When you have the opportunity, you might thank him for his service given to our parish.
