## Hetzel's Harbor -

## 17th Sunday in Ordinary Time - 27 July 2025



This story of Sodom and Gomorrah that we hear in our first reading this weekend, what relevance does it have for us today? If we look at this story, it can teach us something about the nature of God and our relationship with him. Those who follow God's teachings can plead with God for good things and God does hear our prayers. God wants justice: He wants good things for the innocent, but also to punish wrongdoing. As Abraham's negotiating with God goes on, we can see that when a conflict arises between punishing wrongdoing and mercifully protecting the innocent, God prefers mercy. Though God punishes wrongdoing, He does not rush into this, but only does so when fully justified.

What does this mean for us? God is good. Bad things happen and we do not always know why. Sometimes, there might be a punishment for a wrong done. Sometimes, we might not be the ones at fault. We often do not know. What we do know is that God wants good things for us and God wants justice. We also know that God hears our prayers. Keep praying for good things. Pray for good things for yourselves. Pray for good things for your loved ones. Pray for good things for the whole world. Pray.
