For a few weeks there will be times when the previously scheduled multiple intentions will be celebrated, but hopefully by the first of 2022, we will be in full compliance.

Weekday Masses and Sanctuary Candle intentions are available also.

COVID Guidelines: In light of the changing circumstances of the Covid virus and in an effort to maintain a safe environment being mindful of the common good for all, Bishop Bonnar has issued a revised temporary guideline for those attending Sunday Mass.

This recommendation is temporary and will be re-evaluated in the coming weeks.
