We end October and begin November. I finish writing and editing this bulletin column after I paused to read Bishop Bonnar's letter that also mentions some of these same topics. As a Church, we take time every November to remember our beloved departed. We ask the countless Blessed in Heaven to intercede for us. We then remember those who continue to need the assistance of our prayers. We have all sinned and fall short of the glory of God (see Rom 3:23). Though our God has forgiven us, how often do we still feel shame over the wrongs we have done? When we are called to eternal reward, we need to not have this weight holding us down. God desires to purge this from us so that we can enjoy eternal bliss with Him. If this purging is not finished in this earthly life, the reality of what purging is left for us we call Purgatory. This is not a punishment, but a final time of healing, a final preparation for the joys of Heaven. We, on earth, have not only the power, but the duty to assist those in Purgatory with our prayers. We do this on All Souls' Day. We do this at every funeral and memorial Mass. We also dedicate time throughout November to call attention to this important spiritual work of mercy.


